As part of this effort, the **Wake Forest Institute for Regenerative Medicine (WFIRM) Young Investigator Award** will be presented at the 2018 Biofabrication Conference. The award is designed to recognize outstanding achievements by members of the International Society for Biofabrication (ISBF) who are in the early stages of career in biofabrication. We are pleased to request nominations for the award to be given at the 2017 Biofabrication Conference in Würzburg, Germany.

The WFIRM Young Investigator Award will be presented to one individual in the early stages of their research careers (graduate student or post-doctoral fellow). The awardee will be presented with a certificate and a monetary award of \$1000 (US).

- Attached application form
- Applicant's current CV
- A copy of one of the applicant's 2018 Biofabrication Conference abstracts
- A one-page Personal Statement describing the applicant's career goals
- One letter of recommendation

All eligible individuals are encouraged to apply. In order to be eligible for the award, the applicant must meet the following **criteria:**

- Currently enrolled as a student in an advanced degree program (Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent) **OR** currently a post-doctoral fellow
- Actively involved in any area of biofabrication research
- Have an accepted abstract for 2018 Biofabrication Conference
- Be in attendance at the 2018 Biofabrication Conference in Würzburg, Germany
- No affiliation with Wake Forest University or Wake Forest University Health Sciences

The award winner will be selected by a review panel and award will be presented at the 2018 Biofabrication Conference in Würzburg, Germany.
